


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Sightsavers

In the village of ______, there lived a big brother named ______ and a little sister named ______. Their best friend was a dinosaur named Bobo.



<u>For students:</u> What does Bobo say to his friends? The students can draw clothes for Bobo and color the characters.

Every morning Big Brother wakes up and washes his hands and face with soap and water. He helps Little Sister wash her hands and face too.

<u>For students</u>: Pretend you are Big Brother. Show Little Sister how to wash her hands and face by acting out the steps.

How to Wash Your Hands and Face



1. Wet your hands with water.



2. Rub your hands

with soap until it



3. Rub your

hands from

palm to palm.



4. Rub one hand over the other with fingers interlocking.



5. Use your soapy hands to wash your face. Keep your eyes closed.

6. Rinse hands

with water.



7. Rinse face with water to make sure all soap is gone.




8. Dry by shaking hands or using a clean towel.




On the walk to school, Big Brother explains to Little Sister that they need to wash their face and hands to protect them from bad germs that can make them sick. Germs like to live in dirty places, especially on poop and flies.

<u>For students:</u> 1) Help brother and sister get to school safely by circling all the areas with germs so they can avoid them. 2) Draw a clean school for them in the box at the bottom.



When Big Brother and Little Sister get to school, they see their friend Bobo. His hands and face are dirty, and his eyes are red. He feels sick!




<u>For students:</u> On the left is sick Bobo. On the right is healthy Bobo. Can you circle all the differences between the two pictures?




The teacher told Bobo that he should go to see a health worker. She asked Big Brother to walk with him to the health center, since there are many turns along the way.

<u>For students</u>: Draw a route for Big Brother and Bobo to walk from school to the health center.




The health worker says that Bobo has trachoma and gives him medicine to take. She explains that if you don't treat and prevent trachoma, then you can have more eye problems and even blindness.



The health worker says, "Medicine is not enough. You also need to practice healthy behaviors so you don't get sick again."

<u>For students</u>: On the left are unhealthy habits. For each bad habit, draw a line to the correct healthy habit that they should do instead. As an example, they should use a clean towel instead of a dirty one.

<u>For students:</u> Pretend you are Big Brother. Explain when to wash your hands and face to Bobo. Do you have a song to teach him that can help him remember?
